

Terms and Conditions of the Altenhof Treetop Adventure Park and any events offered by the FördeAkademie

- 1** The equipment and courses in our adventure and events area may only be used by persons with a minimum height of at least 110cm and a minimum age of 7 years (these requirements are, however, valid for only part of the Treetop Adventure Park). Children under 8 years of age must be accompanied at all times by another person, who must be at least 14 years of age. Persons with a minimum height of 140cms and who are at least 13 years of age are free to climb all 12 courses. Children under 8 years of age must be accompanied and supervised at all times within the grounds of the Treetop Adventure Park
The entry points to all courses are clearly signposted with the age and height requirements for each course. The team area may only be used when booked and only under the supervision of our trained staff. Our staff are easily identifiable by their orange t-shirts with logo, white or orange rain jackets and/or orange helmets.
- 2** Children and adolescents under 18 years of age may only climb with the written consent of a parent, supervising adult or legal guardian.
- 3** Participants are asked to appreciate that the use of the Treetop Adventure Park and any and all other corresponding additional offers (crate climbing, outdoor games, etc.) and events within the FördeAkademie (raft building, GPS Tour, BBQ etc.) is associated with risks. Participants use the park at their own risk. Should there be any liability on the part of the Treetop Adventure Park for any damage other than those from injury to life, body or health. Employees or other auxiliary persons are not liable unless the damage is a direct result of their negligence or misconduct.
- 4** Participants of all events may not be under the influence of alcohol, drugs, medication that might impair their physical or mental capabilities. People who suffer from physical or psychological conditions that may prove to be a danger to themselves or others in the Treetop Adventure Park may not climb in the interests of their own and others' safety. Pregnant women may not climb in the Treetop Adventure Park. Participants must be under 140kg
- 5** Before using the Treetop Adventure Park, each participant must read our Terms and Conditions of Usage and have participated in a safety briefing .
- 6** The Park may only be used during our official opening times. An employee of the Treetop Adventure Park must be present on site at all times during climbing.
- 7** No participant is permitted to be unsecured in any of our climbing courses. The participants in the adventure and events area must always be secured with at least one safety hook which should be connected to your climbing harness. Participants found to be unsecured will be immediately excluded from climbing further and their entrance fee will not be refunded.
- 8** For the entire duration of your stay and during any events that take place at the Altenhof Treetop Adventure Park all participants must strictly adhere to and follow any and all decisions and instructions made by our staff. Any participant failing to do so will be excluded from climbing. We reserve the right to claim compensation for such behaviour and the entrance fee will not be refunded . All visitors must behave appropriately whilst on the premises.
- 9** Elements between platforms may only be climbed by one individual at a time (apart from in our Team Area). A maximum of two persons may stand on a platform at any one time.
- 10** Only equipment (harness, helmet, safety hooks etc.) provided by the Altenhof Treetop Adventure Park may be used in the park. Participants are not permitted to remove or put on equipment without the supervision of our trained staff. Any equipment damaged through inappropriate use or recklessness of the user must be paid for. Participants may not take any items (mobile phones, cigarette lighters, cameras, etc.) into the climbing courses. Long hair must be tied up. All jewellery must be removed as well as any items where there is a danger of snagging (earrings, scarves, rings, etc.). The Treetop Adventure Park accepts no liability for any damages caused to third parties by our customers.
- 11** Visitors may use only those paths clearly marked out within the Treetop Adventure Park.
- 12** The Altenhof Treetop Adventure Park is an absolute no smoking zone. Smokers are asked to smoke only in the designated areas and to remove their harnesses before doing so.
- 13** Visitors are asked to assume responsibility for looking after their own personal possessions. The Altenhof Treetop Adventure park accepts no liability for loss, damage or theft of any participant's personal belongings.
- 14** All accidents, any damage to the Park and/or climbing equipment and all injuries must be reported to staff immediately.
- 15** The FördeAkademie Treetop Adventure Park reserves the right to halt any and all activities for safety reasons (fire, storm, accident). In such cases, entrance fees will not be refunded.
- 16** Group leaders are responsible for the adherence of group members to the terms and conditions of usage.
- 17** We strongly advice any prospective participants suffering from vertigo, circulatory problems, epilepsy, who have recently undergone surgery and those with injuries or other bodily or spinal limitations, who are pregnant or have any other restrictive illnesses to seek out the consent of a medical doctor or the consent of a parent/legal guardian or primary care giver before visiting the Altenhof Treetop Adventure Park.
- 18** The invalidity of certain single, specific clauses of our terms and conditions shall not affect its validity in entirety. In such cases, the concerned parties (FördeAkademie Altenhof Treetop Adventure Park/ Participants) undertake to formulate a clause or clauses that closely resemble/s the initial invalid clause or clauses in terms of meaning and purpose.
- 19** Jurisdiction, Applicable Law
The jurisdiction is Kiel . The law is that of the Federal Republic of Germany
